

Art, Craft ,Design (Grennan Mill Craft School)

Aim:

The Grennan Mill Craft School, founded in 1981 by County Kilkenny VEC is an important centre for the study of crafts and attracts students from all over Ireland and further afield.

This two year full-time programme is designed to give students an insight into the design and making of craftwork. The course aims, under the guidance of specialised teachers, to equip students with the skills to enable them to make a decision about a possible future in craft. The course is further complemented by a series of visiting lecturers on a broad range of craft/art related subjects, visits to exhibitions and field trips.



Certification:

This programme is validated and externally examined by FETAC(Level 5 Certificate).

Entrance Requirements

Applicants should be at least 17 years of age with in the Leaving Certificate/ Leaving Certificate Applied or equivalent. A confidential report from your school principal or art teacher must accompany the application form. **Mature Students**(23 years of age or over) are welcome to apply. Applicants need not have the normal minimum entry requirements to apply for courses. A portfolio of work, which should include: design work, sketch, books, life drawings, nature studies, craftwork and photographs of any large 3D work. (about 25 pieces in total).
