

Uniform Details

The school uniform is a fundamental aspect of the school identity and it presents many advantages for the school community.

- It creates a sense of equality among all students and eliminates competition.
- It reduces expense on parents/guardians.
- It reinforces a sense of pride among students in their school especially when representing the school on sporting or extracurricular activities.

Parents / guardians are requested to ensure that each pupil attends school each day in a **full, clean & in good condition uniform**. Failure/consistent failure to comply with the Uniform dress code will result in sanctions being applied.

All items of uniform (school & PE) should be labelled or identified clearly with the students' name **Uniform Details**

- Blue school jumper with Grennan College crest
- Blue school shirt
- Blue plaid school skirt (knee length **minimum**)
- Grey school pants (boys and girls)
- Black, brown or navy shoes/ankle boots (**not runners**) must be worn by all students.
- Coat – navy with school crest.

Availability:

- Woods Drapery, Thomastown, Uniform World, Market Cross, Kilkenny
- The college P.E. tracksuit (**Plain navy** tracksuit pants; all students - available in Woods Drapery, Thomastown & Hennessy Sports, Kilkenny). 1st, 2nd & 3rd Year 2021-2022 = plain white polo shirt or (as with 3rd Years to 6th Years) navy polo tshirt/school jersey (with school crest), & school half-zip (**available from the college**)

Presentation and wearing the college uniform:

The school tracksuit, t-shirt/jersey and runners must be worn during PE. Students can wear their PE uniform in and out of school on their PE day.

The following details should be noted in particular:

- Shirts should be buttoned up to the second button at least.
- Skirts should be worn at knee length minimum (**not rolled up**).
- Shoes/ankle boots (not trainers/runners) must be worn.
- School coats or school PE half zip are not a substitute for the uniform jumper.
- School coats only are permissible; half-zips can only be worn for PE/sports. All students are expected to wear the specified uniform at all times i.e. while travelling to and from school as well as on all school related activities.
