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### **Uniform Policy**

#### **Uniform Details**

- Blue school jumper with Grennan College crest
- Blue school shirt
- Blue and Grey school tie
- New blue plaid school skirt
- Grey school pants (Robbie) (For boys only). Cord trousers are not acceptable.
- Black, brown or navy **shoes** (not runners) must by worn by all students.
- Girls must wear either navy knee socks or navy tights.

## **Availability**

- 2. The college **jacket** ( $\in$ 50) and the college **tracksuit** are available directly from the college.

# Presentation and wearing the college uniform

The uniform must be maintained in neat condition.
