



Uniform Policy

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The school uniform is a fundamental aspect of the school identity and it presents many advantages for the school community.

Uniform Details

- Blue school jumper with Grennan College crest
- Blue school shirt
- Blue and Grey school tie
- New blue plaid school skirt
- Grey school pants (Robbie) (For boys only). **Cord trousers are not acceptable.**
- Black, brown or navy **shoes** (not runners) must be worn by all students.
- Girls must wear either navy knee socks or navy tights.

Presentation and wearing the college uniform

The uniform must be maintained in neat condition.
